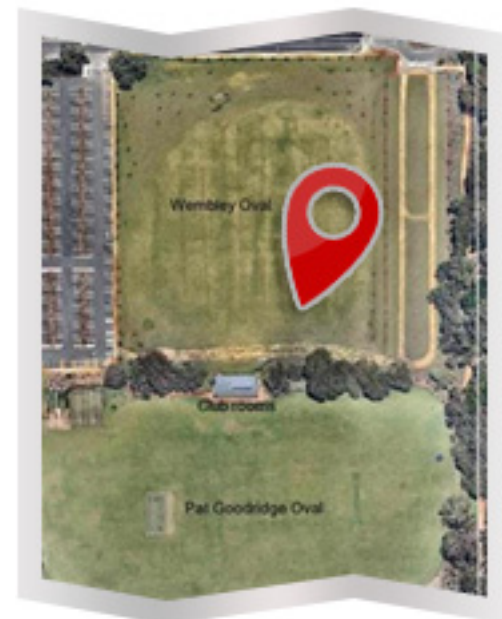

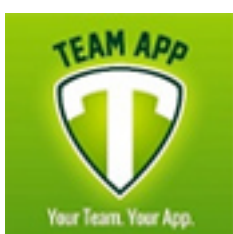
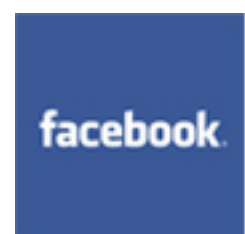

Season 2016 - Promises to be a Big One

It's not too early to start thinking about next season: Key focus areas for 2016 include:

Increasing our financial strength via sponsorship, membership and other means- our \$10k contribution to the new clubrooms is a necessary and important step for our future

Building on great recruitment numbers in 2015 - need some young stock (and old stock is fine too!) to boost our ranks and keep the club sustainable for many years

Greater disclosure of player information - helping players and sponsors to get the most out of their connection to the club

So plans are already underway to deliver a big 2016 - talk to your committee if you have any suggestions.

A big thanks to Wal and the 2014/15 committee which has built a solid base for the future.

2. Wembley Sports Precinct - Building fund

Firm Construction has been awarded the contract to build the new clubrooms (c. \$3M build)

Construction of new building to commence in November 2015 with completion expected November 2016



Once new building completed, existing Pat Goodridge (current) clubrooms will be refurbished for completion in 2017 - this means we will have full use of current clubrooms in 2016 and then new clubrooms in 2017

Wembley Athletics Club (WAC) and its members (including WVFC) have been asked to contribute \$220k to the fit-out - planned financing structure as follows:

\$150k overdraft loan to the WAC (secured via Town of Cambridge guarantee)

\$70k contribution by WAC and its members including a suggested \$10k from WVFC and \$25k from Wembley Magpies

The WVFC Committee has reviewed the funding request from the WAC and we will pay \$10k in two tranches - \$5k in 2015 and \$5k in 2016. Our money will be integral to creating a magnificent facility and we are keen to see that, once it is built, how best it can bring financial, playing and other benefits to our club and all WAC members
